<i>Austrostipa verticillata</i>	Slender Bamboo Grass	40	Tall grass, common in moist areas, often red soils & deep sands Neat plant 10cm x 40cm, lilac-blue fl. Spring & Summer. Well drained, full sun
<i>Brachycome multifida</i>	Cut Leaf Daisy		
<i>Bulbine bulbosa</i>	Bulbine Lily	58	Erect tufted perennial to 50cm, succulent linear leaves, spikes of yellow flowers. Most soils & aspects
<i>Chrysocephalum apiculatum</i>	Yellow Buttons		Yellow flowered perennial to 60cm x 90cm, silvery green foliage, well drained sunny aspect
<i>Cymbopogon refractus</i>	Barbed-wire Grass	35	Perennial, widespread, free draining soils of lower fertility. Aromatic stems & foliage
<i>Dianella sp.</i>	Flax Lily		Blue flowered perennial with strappy leaves, followed by blue berries. Well drained soils, at least half sun
<i>Dichopogon fimbriatus</i>	Nodding Chocolate Lily	80	Tuberous perennial to 60cm with grass-like leaves. Fragrant mauve flowers Spring & Summer. Most well drained soils, full sun
<i>Hardenbergia violacea</i>	False Sarsaparilla	67	Climbing or prostrate subshrub, widespread, various habitats
<i>Linum marginale</i>	Native Flax		Erect, slender perennial to 60cm. Open bright blue flowers Spring & Summer. Most soils, full sun to part shade
<i>Microseris lanceolata</i>	Murnong or Yam Daisy		Perennial with tuberous roots & basal leaves. Bright yellow flower heads on stems to 40cm. Most soils & a sunny aspect
<i>Poa labillardieri</i>	Poa Tussock		Cool season long lived coarse perennial. Tolerates wet feet. Good to filter water entering dams & other water sources
<i>Themeda triandra</i>	Kangaroo Grass		Warm season perennial. Foliage often tinged maroon. Inflorescence orange in frosts. Variety of well drained soils, full sun.
<i>Clematis glycinoides</i>	Headache Vine/Old Man's Beard	5	Vigorous climber, not too heavy, partially deciduous. Creamy white fl. Spring, fluffy seed heads Summer. Roots need mulching

<i>Acacia cultriformis</i>	Knife-leaved Wattle	13	Erect shrub 2.5x2m. Well drained sunny location
<i>Acacia dealbata</i>	Silver Wattle	8	Shrub or tree to 30m, variety of soils, oft. creek flats
<i>Acacia decora</i>	Western Silver Wattle	11	1 - 4 m, variety of soils incl. rocky situations
<i>Acacia falcata</i>	Hickory Wattle	3	Erect tree like shrub to 4m. Cream balls flowers early Winter. V. hardy
<i>Acacia fimbriata</i>	Fringed Wattle	14	Bushy shrub to 7m high, drier slopes
<i>Acacia gladiiformis</i>	Sword Wattle	4	Several stemmed shrub, curved foliage dark green & leathery. Free draining to rocky soils, sun best.
<i>Acacia implexa</i>	Hickory Wattle	5	Shrub or tree, 5-12m, variety of soils
<i>Acacia iteaphylla</i>	Flinders Range Wattle	16	Weeping shrub to 5m, well drained position
<i>Acacia melanoxylon</i>	Blackwood Wattle	30	Shrub or tree 6-30m, moist soils at altitude
<i>Acacia spectabilis</i>	Mudgee Wattle	2	Large shrub with tree like form to 6m. Full sun & well drained soils, sandy or gavelly best.
<i>Acacia vestita</i>	Hairy Wattle	5	Rounded shrub 1 - 4m, variety of soils or sheltered gullies
<i>Atriplex numularia</i>	Old Man Saltbush		Handsome erect shrub to 3mx2m, well drained full sun
<i>Banksia ericifolia</i>	Heath Banksia	3	Rounded bushy shrub to 5m x 4m. Fl. Autumn & Winter. Prefers well drained soils, full sun to light shade
<i>Correa alba</i>	White Correa	36	Rounded shrub 1.5m x 1m, well drained, full sun
<i>Correa 'Dusky Bells'</i>	Native Fuschia	17	Rounded shrub 1m x 1m, well drained, full sun
<i>Correa glabra</i>	Rock Correa	30	Rounded shrub to 2m x 2m, green bell shaped flowers winter. Well drained, half shade
<i>Correa reflexa</i>	Native Fuschia	6	Variable shrub. Bell shaped flowers greenish to red with yellow tips. Well drained, full to part sun
<i>Eucalyptus latens 'Moon Lagoon'</i>		6	Mallee formed shrub to 4m x 3m, Full sun. well drained soil, neutral to alkaline. Prune 2-4yrly to maintain juvenile foliage
<i>Grevillea lanigera</i>	Woolly Grevillea	12	Low shrub to 30cm x 1.5m, well drained & sunny. Fl. Ed & cream, late Winter and Spring
<i>Grevillea 'Sunrise'</i>		6	Small bushy shrub 1m x 1m, apricot flowers Spring & Summer, well drained, full sun
<i>Grevillea 'Winparra Gem'</i>			Fast growing shrub, 2m x 3m, red flowers most of year, Well drained, full to part sun
<i>Indigofera australis</i>	Austral Indigo		Open shrub to 2m x 2m, purple pea fl. Spring, sun or shade, reasonable drainage, most soils
<i>Melaleuca thymifolia</i>	Thyme Honey-Myrtle	2	1-2m, heath & scrubland, damp places & swamp margins. Mauve flowers mostly Summer.
<i>Leptospermum polygalifolium</i>	Tea Tree	1	Variable, often rounded shrub. Prouision of white flowers late Spring & Summer. Hardy most soils & aspects
<i>Rhaqodia spinescens</i>	Spiny Saltbush	12	Grey foliaged medium shrub 1.5m x 3m, most free drainng soils, full sun
<i>Westringia 'Wynabbie Gem'</i>	Coast Rosemary	17	Compact shrub to 2m x 2m, mauve fl. Most of year. Well drained sunny location

<i>Angophora floribunda</i>	Rough Barked Apple		To 30m, deep free draining soils
<i>Eucalyptus albens</i>	White Box		To 25m, various fertile soils
<i>Eucalyptus blakelyi</i>	Blakelys Red Gum		To 20m, various moderately fertile soils, also at altitude
<i>Eucalyptus bridgesiana</i>	Apple Box		To 20m, favours drier sites on heavier alluvial soils
<i>Eucalyptus caesia 'Silver Princess'</i>		6	Attactive small ornamental tree, to 8m x 4m. Well drained, full sun
<i>Eucalyptus camaldulensis</i>	River Red Gum	40	To 35m, rich soil, near permanent water, mostly West of Mudgee
<i>Eucalyptus leucoxylo 'Rosea Dwarf'</i>	Euky Dwarf		Small tree to 6m x 5m, red fl. Autumn to Spring. Well drained, full sun to light shade.
<i>Eucalyptus mannifera</i>	Brittle Gum		Attractive white trunked tree to 20m x 13m. Naturally on well drained poorer soils
<i>Eucalyptus melliodora</i>	Yellow Box		To 30m, moderately fertile sandy/alluvial fre draining soils. Grassy Woodlands
<i>Eucalyptus microcarpa</i>	Western Grey Box		To 25m, loamy soils of moderate fertility
<i>Eucalyptus nicholii</i>	Narrow-leaved Peppermint		To 20m, pendulous habit. Good shade tree. Water sparingly
<i>Eucalyptus polanthesmos</i>	Red Box		To 20m, light, shallow soils, widespread.
<i>Eucalyptus sideroxylo</i>	Mugga Ironbark		To 35m, best on light, free draining, poorer soils
<i>Eucalyptus viminalis</i>	Ribbon/Manna Gum		To 50m, fertile loams, mostly at higher altitudes
<i>Hakea salicifolia</i>	Willow Leaved Hakea	7	Small bushy tree to 8m. Free draining soil, full sun. Hardy, fast growing screen plant
