



## Caring for Your Tubestock

1. Tubestock can dry out quickly. Water daily until ready to plant in the ground.
2. To plant, dig a hole 1.5x the size of the pot
3. Plant by gently removing from the tube. Place in the hole and backfill firmly, reforming the soil to form a 'bowl' shape to ensure water/rain does not run off.
4. Add mulch to a depth of 6-8cm, keeping it clear of the stem. Leave the pot beside the plant until it has been watered.
5. Give a deep soak immediately after planting. Adding a seaweed solution will improve growth.

### For best results:

- Water regularly for the first 4-8 weeks, and during prolonged drought conditions in the first year.
- Protect from grazing animals and provide protection from frost and sun with guards or fencing
- keep weeds controlled
